## **-Zack Thomas (Unity)**

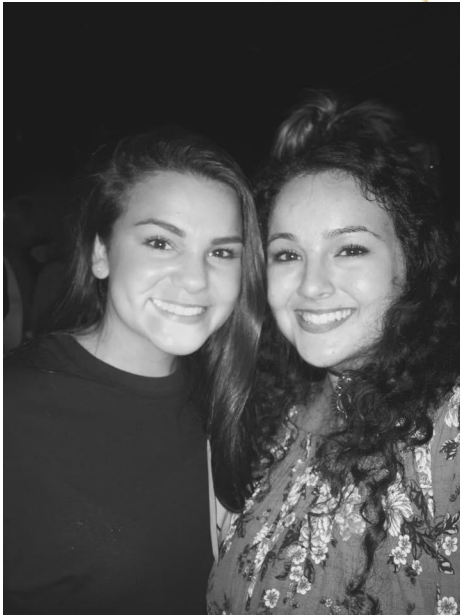
